

Ministerial Intern Committee(s)

Purpose:

To guide and assist ministerial interns to develop and hone personal and professional skills of ministry

Tasks:

- With support of the Senior Minister, recruit and interview suitable candidates for internships. With approval of the Senior Minister, make recommendation to Standing Committee to hire a candidate for internship.
- Orient, support, advise and reflect with student interns on their experiences in the congregational setting as follows:
 - Welcome, introduce and orient interns in becoming acquainted with congregation
 - Assist interns in maximizing the effectiveness of their congregational experience
 - Guide interns in obtaining broad involvement in all the required learning areas
 - Provide feedback and support during the learning process
 - Explore together how the congregation lives its faith and performs its mission
 - Encourage thoughtful reflection on how the ministry informs one's theology, and how one's theology informs one's ministry
- Organize appropriate closure for the intern and the congregation at the end of the ministerial internship.

Structure:

If there is more than one intern, each intern has a separate committee
